






PRINT COLLATERAL








PUBLICATIONS

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



































TRADITIONAL CHIN GAME

I redesigned the traditional Chin game Rualdih! to incorporate Chin language, patterns, history, and geography, restoring its original Chin name to support linguistic preservation. Now played in multiple Chin organizations across the U.S., Rualdih! fosters language use, cultural appreciation, and community connection through engaging, meaningful play.







ART AND PHOTOGRAPHY

Alongside graphic design, my visual art and exhibitions highlight Chin culture, history, and contemporary life, portraying both challenges and resilience through drawing and painting. I regularly exhibit in Chin communities across the United States, preserving stories and educating younger generations through visual storytelling. I also provide photography, printing, and framing services for families in traditional clothing, offering accessible and culturally sensitive ways to document and celebrate Chin identity.





EXHIBITION TABLE

For our MFA program's final exhibition, my cohort created a custom table of interlocking shapes, each representing a student. I co-led the design, fabrication, and assembly, from concept sketches and Rhino renderings to CNC cutting, sanding, and painting. Serving as both a functional display and a sculptural symbol of unity, the table became the exhibition's centerpiece, praised for its craftsmanship and its ability to foster conversation and reflection.
